HUMAN AND NATURAL CAUSES

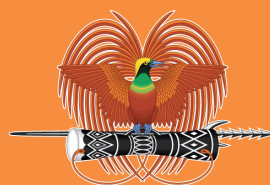
Earth's climate naturally changes over time due to natural occurrences. However, human activities also contributed to it substantially.
